

## Use Form to Certify Victim Status, Assert VAWA Protections

If a tenant asserts VAWA's protections, you can ask the tenant to certify that he or she is a victim of domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, or stalking. You are not required to demand official documentation and may rely upon the victim's statement alone. Use of a certification form allows a streamlined option for survivors to assert VAWA rights without obtaining a police report or restraining order that may be hard to obtain during this time.

The following form is based on HUD Form 5382 and covers third-party documentation options in lieu of the form and the confidentiality details of the information submitted. If the survivor chooses to use the following form, unless there's conflicting information related to the request for VAWA protection, no certification beyond this form may be required.

### MODEL FORM

#### **CERTIFICATION OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE, DATING VIOLENCE, SEXUAL ASSAULT, OR STALKING, AND ALTERNATE DOCUMENTATION**

**Purpose of Form:** The Violence Against Women Act (VAWA) protects applicants and tenants from being evicted based on acts of domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, or stalking against them. Despite the name of this law, VAWA protection is available to victims of domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, and stalking, regardless of sex, gender identity, or sexual orientation.

**Use of This Optional Form:** If you are seeking VAWA protections from your site's owner, your site owner may give you a written request that asks you to submit documentation about the incident or incidents of domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, or stalking.

In response to this request, you or someone on your behalf may complete this optional form and submit it to your housing provider, or you may submit one of the following types of third-party documentation:

1. A letter signed by a victim services provider (such as a domestic or sexual violence counselor), attorney, or a medical or mental health professional who has helped you with the abuse. You must also sign this letter;
2. A police report, court record (such as a protective or restraining order), or administrative record; or
3. At the discretion of the owner, a statement or other evidence provided by the applicant or tenant.

**Confidentiality:** All information provided concerning the incident(s) of domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, or stalking shall be kept confidential and such details shall not be entered into any shared database. Site employees are not to have access to these details unless to grant or deny VAWA protections to you, and such employees may not disclose this information to any other entity or individual, except to the extent that disclosure is: (i) consented to by you in writing in a time-limited release; (ii) required for use in an eviction proceeding; or (iii) otherwise required by applicable law.
