

Use Self-Employment Affidavit to Verify Anticipated Net Income

In the case of an applicant or resident earning money as a newly independent contractor or business without a history of tax returns, have the applicant or resident tenant complete the self-employed affidavit certifying to the anticipated amount in the next 12 months. You should also request current copies of gross receipts (such as bank statements, cash receipts, customer payment logs, etc.), and an accountant's statement of quarterly earnings and taxes paid, if available. It's also good to request details of expenses paid by the business.

This affidavit can also be used for those who have been self-employed for many years. Have the applicant/resident supply tax returns along with a Schedule C for year submitted year. The applicant or resident completes the affidavit certifying the anticipated income for the next 12 months. If the amount is deviates significantly from what the tax returns support, additional documentation may be required to determine the accuracy of the certified amount.
